The music of UK cellist Jo Quail, performed on solo cello, presents a complex path from meditative ambience to dark brooding urgency; live looping and layers combine atonality with rich orchestration, deft percussion and several unusual instruments often added to create majestic soundscapes.

Jo Quail visited the Florentine in January 2010 and on a warm summer day suffered a drenching in the rainforest. Less than 30 hours later Jo premiered **Tu Florentine**, an amazing piece that describes her experience. **Tu Florentine** creates the contrast of sticky humidity and clear raindrops on that day in the forest.
